

COOPERATION AGREEMENT
between
KHMELNYTSKY NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (Ukraine)
and
LEPL IVANE JAVAKHISHVILI TBILISI STATE UNIVERSITY (Georgia)

Khmelnysky National University (Ukraine) and LEPL Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University (Georgia) for the purpose of increasing educational, scientific, and cultural possibilities, promotion of educational exchanges and international cooperation, based on the Cooperation Agreement between the Government of Ukraine and the Government of Georgia in the field of education, signed 31.08.1996, agree on the following:

1. OBJECTIVES OF COOPERATION;

- 1.1 Establishment of mutually advantageous educational, scientific and cultural relations between the educational institutions.
- 1.2 Development of relations between academic staff, students, individual scientists, and professors of the educational institutions.
- 1.3 Promotion of integration process of the universities into the world educational and scientific area.

2. TASKS OF COOPERATION

2.1. In the field of educational activity:

- 2.1.1 Exchange of experience in educational process management and teaching methods.
- 2.1.2 Provision of invitations for participation in scientific and methodical conferences and workshops held at each educational institution.
- 2.1.3 Exchange of academic curricula, scientific literature and program packages.
- 2.1.4 Exchange of academic staff.
- 2.1.5 Exchange of students.
- 2.1.6 Joint preparing and publishing of the educational textbooks and tutorials.

2.2 In the field of scientific activity:

- 2.2.1 Provision of invitations for participation in scientific and practical conferences and workshops including students conferences.
- 2.2.2 Preparation and publishing of joint scientific works.
- 2.2.3 Bilateral scientific internships of academic staff, undergraduate and postgraduate students.
- 2.2.4 Participation in the preparation and fulfillment of joint scientific projects as well as the projects conducted in the frames of intergovernmental programs and international grants.
- 2.2.5 Exchange of scientific literature published by the academic staff of the educational institutions.

2.3 In the field of administration:

2.3.1 Mutual visits of administration representatives from both educational institutions for consultations, coordination of agreement conditions, and experience exchange in the field of higher educational institution management.

3. ORGANIZATION OF AGREEMENT FULFILLMENT

3.1 Each side appoints a person responsible for the agreement fulfillment.

3.2 Implementation of each concrete activity, envisaged by this basic agreement will be enforced by additional written consent between the sides, which will become the supplements to the active agreement.

4. AMENDMENTS AND TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT

4.1 Changes can be implemented into the agreement on the basis of the written consent of the both sides.

4.2 In the case of unilateral cancellation of the agreement the side is obliged to inform another side about it in the written form not later than 6 months before the cancellation.

5. DURATION OF THE AGREEMENT

5.1 Agreement is signed for five years.

5.2 The period of agreement validity can be prolonged under the mutual consent of both educational institutions.

6. AGREEMENT CONFIRMATION

6.1 Agreement comes into action from the moment of its signing by both sides.

6.2 Agreement is drawn up in English language in 2 originals, both having equal legal power



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
